



TITLE VI POLICY STATEMENT

The El Dorado County Transit Authority (El Dorado Transit) is committed to providing public transportation in an environment that is free from discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity. El Dorado Transit operates its programs, activities and services without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity.

As a Federal Transit Administration (FTA) fund recipient, El Dorado Transit will ensure that its programs, policies and activities comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and Department of Transportation regulations.

Any person, who believes that he/she, has been subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, nation origin, age, sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity, with respect to El Dorado Transit's programs, activities, services, or other transit related benefits, may file a Title VI complaint. Complaints must be filed in writing and signed by the complainant, or a representative, and should include the complainants name, address, and telephone number or other means by which the complainant can be contacted. Complaints must be filed within 180 days of the date of the alleged discriminatory act.
