**BACKGROUND**

The members of the Transit Advisory Committee (TAC) shall select a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson, and the Chairperson's responsibility shall be to preside at all meetings. The Vice-Chairperson shall act in the absence of the Chairperson with all rights and responsibilities.

**DISCUSSION**

El Dorado County Transit Authority (EDCTA) was established with a Joint Powers Agreement between the County of El Dorado and the City of Placerville on January 1, 1994. Included in the By-Laws was the formation of the Transit Advisory Committee (TAC). It is the responsibility of the TAC to review the operation of the transit system, monitor levels of service such that they fall within funding constraints and provide advice to the Transit Director.

The Transit Advisory Committee meets bimonthly to review budgetary and operational issues. Membership consists of one (1) representative for a total of nine (9) members. The following members represent the Transit Advisory Committee:
